WHEREAS, the RMC has secured an alternate proposal, underwritten by the Standard Life Insurance Company that provides:

- coverage enhancements to the current coverage contract,
- a 33% savings in annual premium costs to the Township (using equal coverage limits),

- three (3) year rate guarantee

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of South Hackensack, County of Bergen, the RMC is hereby authorized and directed to effectuate with the Standard Insurance Company, the existing coverage level, in accordance with the spreadsheet analysis provided by the RMC and made a part of this Resolution, for a August 1, 2008 effective date or as soon thereafter as administratively practical and also to communicate the benefit enhancements to the affected employees soon after adoption of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that payment of the monthly premium, which has been annualized, as indicated in the analysis developed by the RMC and attached herewith is hereby authorized and directed to the Township's Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer for satisfaction; and

A Resolution Providing for a Meeting Not Open to the Public in Accordance with the Provisions of the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.

Whereas, the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack is subject to certain requirements of the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, et seq.*, and

Whereas, the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12*, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution, and

Whereas, it is necessary for the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below:

\_\_\_\_(1) *Matters Required by Law to be Confidential*: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.

\_\_\_\_(2) *Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds*: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.

\_\_\_\_(3) *Matters Involving Individual Privacy*: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or

program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.

(4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.

(5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.
