Call of Meeting to Order

Mayor Romano called the Regular Meeting to order at 7:58 p.m. She advised that pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act adequate notice of the meetings had been provided to *The Record*, *The Herald and News* and by posting a notice on the bulletin board in the clerk's office where notices are customarily posted. Everyone saluted the flag. The municipal clerk called the roll.

911 Remembrance

County Clerk, Kathleen Donovan was present to administer a silent prayer in remembrance of the tragic events that occurred on September 11th.

Correspondence & Reports

Anzevino motioned; Eckel seconded and the Committee unanimously approved the correspondence dated September 3, 2008, from Chief Michael Frew to allow Katherina Conti to intern in the police department for credits towards her criminal justice degree.

Anzevino motined; Maceri seconded and the Committee unanimously accepted the Monthly Department reports for August and requested that they be placed on file.

Old Business

Paper Recycling Contract

Carbone indicated that the current vendor is willing to take all types and that there is a difference in the rates among the two proposals that were submitted. Jim indicated that he asked the DPW Supt to attend and report on the service of the current vendor. Since Larry Paladino was not in attendance: **Romano motioned; Roman seconded and the Committee unanimously agreed to carry this matter to the October worksession.**

130 Wesley Street – Property Acquisition Area

The letter dated August 21, 2008 from Gregg Padovano expressed an interest in obtaining the available property along Wesley Street for Pharma Chem who has a pending application before the Township Planning Board. Frank Krupinski has reviewed Job and Job's acquisition sketch and the metes and bounds and has reported in a memo dated September 10, 2008 that the new line be set parallel to the existing right of way line and 7 feet off the curb and that the westerly line be at right angles to the new line.

Barbara Nemchek reviewed the assessors letter dated September 11, 2008 and amended the square footage amount that George reported of 4762 s.f. to 4644 s.f. The cost to license, lease, or easement would be an equalized value of \$20.46 per s.f. Carbone will advise the attorney of the information presented on the acquisition.

Eckel motioned; Roman seconded to approve Resolution No. 2008-146 for 130 Wesley Street Acquisition. Ayes: Eckel, Maceri, Roman, Romano Abstain: Anzevino.

New Business

Anzevino inquired about the status of Jim Riley and Carol Perone's resignation letters and was informed by Carbone that this would be discussed at the October worksession.

Ordinances

Resolutions

Anzevino motioned; Maceri seconded and the Committee unanimously approved Consent Agenda Resolution 2008-09.

Committee Reports

Eckel is concerned that the fire and ambulance vehicles are not being checked. Anzevino will follow up with Larry on this matter.

Roman inquired about the DPW plow and Romano informed him that if there was money left in the budget closer to year end then it would be purchased. We have been informed by the county that there will be an increase in price of salt and the budget status is not looking good at this point.

Anzevino reflected on September 11th and thanked all that attended the opening day for the LF/SH Soccer Program. He is not in favor of the study with Hackensack to handle our police dispatcher service. Anzevino **motioned** to disban the Committee and to stop all talks with Hackensack. Carbone indicated that this was not the time to make a motion. The motion was not seconded and was withdrawn to discuss at the October worksession.

Maceri reported that Field Day will be held on Saturday September 13, 2008 and registration for the Race Track will be held on September 16th at 7 p.m. in Town Hall for the trip date of October 11th.

Romano referred to Anzevino's request on Hackensack's dispatching and indicated that this municipality continues to incur increases in expenses and that discussion on shared services is to be beneficial for the town.

Public Comments

Roman motioned; Maceri seconded and the Committee unanimously approved to open the meeting to the public.

Dolly Montenegro – Inquired about the status of the Senior Housing and she was informed by Carbone that this would be discussed in closed session.

James Jemerick – Indicated he would like to repair the damage to the water fountain and the fence in Veteran's Park at his own expense instead of going through the insurance. Carbone informed him to submit his request by letter to the municipal clerk.

Jim Sylvestri – Received a letter from Captain Keith H. Bott from Iraq thanking South Hackensack for their care package for the troops. Jim requested this letter be sent to Memorial School along with posting it on the website.

Eckel motioned; Anzevino seconded and the Committee unanimously agreed to close the public session of the meeting.

Closed Session

Roman motioned; Maceri seconded and the Committee unanimously agreed to go into closed executive session at 8:45 p.m. to discuss the following closed session matter:

- Litigation – Contract Senior Citizen Housing Development Project

Eckel motioned; Anzevino seconded and the Committee unanimously agreed to close the closed session and re-open the regular meeting to the public at 9:00 p.m.

Prior to adjournment, the Township Committee took the following action:

Eckel motioned; Maceri seconded to have the mayor authorize and execute the document required for the County to perform a Due Diligence Review on the documents for the Grove Street Senior Housing Project and to be reported back to the Township Committee by November 15th.

Resolution 2008 Authorizing Executive Session

A Resolution Providing for a Meeting Not Open to the Public in Accordance with the Provisions of the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.

Whereas, the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack is subject to certain requirements of the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6*, et seq., and

Whereas, the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12*, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution, and

Whereas, it is necessary for the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below:

____(1) *Matters Required by Law to be Confidential*: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.

____(2) *Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds*: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.

____(3) *Matters Involving Individual Privacy*: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.

____(4) *Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements*: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.

____(5) *Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds*: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.

____(6) *Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property*: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations of possible violations of the law.

X____(7) *Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege*: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is require in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.

- **Senior Citizen Housing Project**

___(8) *Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship*: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.

___(9) *Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty*: Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bears responsibility.

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack, assembled in public session on this date, that an Executive Session closed to the public shall be held in the South Hackensack Township Municipal Complex, 227 Phillips Avenue, South Hackensack, New Jersey, for the discussion of matters relating to the specific items designated above.

It is anticipated that the deliberations conducted in closed session may be disclosed to the public upon the determination of the Township Committee that the public interest will no longer be served by such confidentiality.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack at a public meeting held on May 8, 2008.




I would like to report on some of our accomplishments for the month of August. Checked & cleaned Ejector Station on Grove Street (daily), checked & cleaned Flood Pumps Rt. 46 & Huyler Street (daily), checked & cleaned Ejector Station in Garfield Park (3 times a week), daily check of all sewer lines in both sections of town. Cut grass down park, behind school, along Phillips Ave, Town hall, triangle on the bottom of Phillips Ave ramp, around sign on Phillips Ave, island on Lincoln Street, Green Street, property on Grove Street, and Alarm Station. Swept and edged all around walking track in park. Started to paint white crosswalks & stop lines. Repainted lines & letters at the following locations: Town hall parking lot, fire box (school), and curbs (school). Repainted handicap spaces in town hall lot, park, school, and Dyer Ave. Picked up 3,700 pounds of trash that was left behind by the garbage man.

For the month of August, the Department Of Public Works had 2 pick up days for newspaper, August 12 Th. and August 26 Th. On August 12Th. the Department Of Public Works used 4 men, 2 trucks, 24 man hours, 16 gallons of gas, and both trucks rode a total of 69 miles for a total of 6,580 pounds of paper. On the second pick up day, August 26th, the Department used a total of 3 men, 2 trucks, 18 man hours, 16 gallons of gas; both trucks rode a total of 74 miles for a total of 4,120 pounds of paper. For the month of August, the Department Of Public Works picked up a total of 10,700 pounds of paper.

For the month of August, the Department Of Public Works answered 12 ambulance calls. 12 Medical emergencies. 11 calls were transported to Hackensack Medical Center and 1




