ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 108 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HACKENSACK ENTITLED "FEES"
--

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has reviewed the recommendations of the Township Police Department regarding fees assessed for Towing; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that the fees proposed are reasonable and in accordance with generally accepted fees and cost for towing services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack that Chapter 108 "Fees" be amended and supplemented as follows:

Section I: Chapter 108-21 Chapter 202 "Towing " shall be amended as follows:

108-21 (A)

(1) Service Charges:

- (a) Cars (light) \$125/hr. plus parts.
- (b) Trucks (Medium/Heavy) \$175.00/hr. plus parts.

(2) Towing Charges

- (a) Cars (light) up to 10,000 lbs.- Hook Up \$150.00
- (b) Medium Duty 10,001 to 16,000 lbs. \$250.00/hr.
- (c) Heavy Duty – 16,001 lbs and above \$500/hr.

On Hook Mileage

(a) Light Duty- \$6.00 per loaded mile.

(b) Medium Duty- n/a

(c) Heavy Duty- n/a

(3) Recovery/Winching (In addition to Towing- per truck including driver)

(a) Light/Medium Duty 10,001 to 16,000 lbs. - \$350/hr. charged in half hour increments.

(b) Heavy duty 16,001 lbs. and above- \$600.00/hr. charged in half hour increments.

(4) Specialized Recovery Equipment

(a) Rotator/Crane Recovery Unit- \$1200/hr.

(b) Tractor w. Landoll Trailer or Detach Trailer- \$450.00/hr.

(c) Tractor/Transport Hauler only \$250.00/hr.

(d) Refrigerated Trailer w/Tractor \$450.00/hr.

(e) Box Trailer w/Tractor -\$400.00/hr.

(f) Air Cushion Unit- \$1000.00/hr.

(g) Light Tower - \$250.00/hr.

(h) Pallet Jack- \$200.00 Flat Rate

(i) Rollers- \$200.00 Flat Rate

(j) Any other specialized equipment- \$250.00/hr.

(k) Loader, backhoe, telescopic handler, bulldozer, bobcat \$300.00/hr.
each

(l) Forklift- \$300.00/hr.

(m) Dump truck, Dump trailer w/tractor - \$350.00/hr.

- (n) Roll Off w/container - \$350.00/hr. plus disposal
- (o) Recovery Supervisor Vehicle \$150.00/hr.
- (p) Scene safety equipment, communication equipment, traffic management equipment- \$250.00/hr. each type used.
- (q) Recovery Support Vehicle/Trailer additional recovery equipment- \$350.00/hr.

(5). Labor- all labor a minimum of one (1) hour

- (a) Accident minor clean up and disposal of debris- \$75.00/hr. plus cost of absorbent material used.
- (b) Recovery supervisor and/or level III recovery specialist- \$225.00/hr.
- (c) Certified Towing Operator- \$125/hr. per person
- (d) Manual Laborers- \$100.00/hr. person

(6) Storage- Per Calendar Day (Inside rates at two times outside rates)

- (a) Cars/light trucks- 10x20 space- \$45.00/day
- (b) Trucks (dual wheels) single axle- \$90.00/day
- (c) Tractor/Dump Truck/Tractor- Trailer Combo/Trailers- \$125.00/day per unit.
- (d) Buses- \$150.00/day
- (e) Roll Off- \$125.00 per day for each.
- (f) Cargo/Accident debris/Load storage/vehicle components- 10x20 space- \$45.00 per space per day.
- (g) Rental of tow company supplied trailer post incident- \$500.00/day.

(7). Additional Services

- (a) Fuel/hazmat/cargo spills- Rates per this ordinance plus material costs.
- (b) Hazmat and Trash recovery- Surcharged 10%
- (c) Sub-Contractor services- Add 10% surcharge.
- (d) Administrative charge- after 3rd visit to vehicle- cars only-\$50.00
- (e) Administrative charge- medium/ heavy truck- \$200.00
- (f) After hours release- \$75.00
- (g) Notification Documentation Fee- \$50.00
- (h) Tarping/Wrapping vehicle- \$90.00/cars- \$250.00/trucks.
- (i) Go jacks/skates- \$40.00

Section II: All ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said inconsistency.

Section III: If any portion of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
