#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2019-09**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 158 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HACKENSACK ENTITLED "PEACE AND GOOD ORDER"

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED,** by the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack that Chapter 158 "Peace and Good Order" be amended and supplemented as follows:

**Section I:** Chapter 158 "Peace and Good Order" shall be amended as follows:

<u>Section 158-23 Public Urination</u>— It shall be unlawful for any person to urinate upon public or private property except within facilities designated for said purpose. A violation of this provision shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), imprisonment for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days and/or community service not to exceed ninety (90) days.

**Section II:** All ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said inconsistency.

**Section III:** If any portion of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
