WHEREAS, the original general tax fund levy proposed was \$5,381,269.00; and

WHEREAS, by law the governing body of the Township of South Hackensack is obligated to review said budget and either certify and recommend the proposed budget or certify a reduction in the same; and

WHEREAS, the governing body reviewed said budget and held public hearings relative to the same on May 3, 2007, May 10, 2007 and May 16, 2007 and considered the documentation in support of said budget, comments from the district school superintendent, comments from the public and comments from committee members; and

WHEREAS, the governing body is cognizant and guided by the New Jersey constitutional mandate to each school district to provide a thorough and efficient education; and

WHEREAS, the governing body, for the reasons stated below, believes that the certification of the budget as reflected on the ballot on April 17, 2007 complies with constitutional mandates for a thorough and efficient education.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack that the proposed and defeated school budget be and is hereby

certified in and at the amounts appropriated by the South Hackensack Board of Education and as further set forth on the public ballot on April 17, 2007

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the general school tax levy to be certified by the municipal government is \$5,381,269.00.
