Acceptable Materials

Aluminum Food & Beverage Containers
Aluminum Soda, Beer Cans and pet cans, etc



Ferrous Cans

Tin/Steel Soup, Food, Coffee Cans, etc.

Glass Food & Beverage Containers

Flint (Clear), Amber (Brown), Green



Food and Beverage Cartons

Aseptic Shelf as well as refrigerated milk, juice, soy milk, broth, soup, etc.



Plastic Containers (#1, #2, or #5)

Which may include (please check numbers):












Soda & beverage bottles of various colors, milk and water jugs (narrow neck), detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, bleach bottles (narrow neck), also found in some ketchup bottles, syrup bottles and yogurt containers, etc.

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTABLE

Mirrors, window or auto glass, light bulbs, ceramics, microwave trays, any plastics with no number on them, needles & syringes, hazardous materials, pesticide/chemical/antifreeze and oil containers, paper bags & paper products, plastic bags, plastic film, coat hangers, paint cans, aerosol cans, tar pails, vacuum & pool hoses, pool liners, shower curtains, PVC pipe, plumbing accessories, toys, building products, plastic fencing, wire, electrical equipment, dishwasher, styrofoam, food trays, pots, pans, toasters & small appliances, flower pots, nursery trays, rubber hoses, general household items, bowling balls, food or party trays even if stamped with #1-#2-#5, trash, etc....

What Can Go In My Curbside Container?



Plastic Bottles & Containers

YES: Bottles coded with #1 & #2 on the Bottom



Mixed Paper

YES: Paper, Newspaper, Magazines, Junk Mail, Catalogs & Phone Books



Cans

YES: Aluminum & Steel (tin) Cans & Lids



Glass Bottles & Jars

YES: All Sizes, Shapes & Colors



Cardboard

YES: Corrugated, Cereal & Clean Pizza Boxes



Cartons

YES: Milk, Juice & Food Cartons



PLEASE DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS!

What **Cannot** Go In My Curbside Container?



Plastic Bags

NO: Please do not bag your own recyclables or place plastic bags in recycle bin.



Styrofoam*

NO: Styrofoam cannot be recycled outside.



Dishware, Glass & Mirrors

NO: These items can be thrown in regular garbage.



Shredded Paper

NO: Place shredded paper in regular garbage. (or bring paper to be shredded at county event)



Pots, Pans & Small Appliances



Dirty Pizza Boxes

NO: Leftover Food or Grease



Plastic Containers & Plasticware



These items can be recycled through County recycling events.
