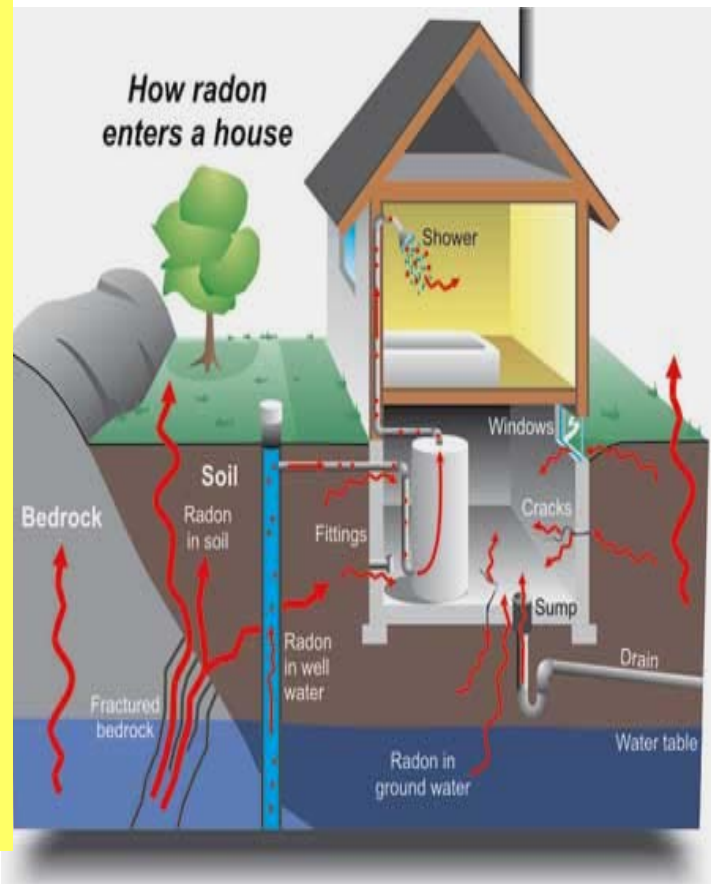

- Released in soil, rock, water and leaks into homes through cracks and other openings in the foundation.

Why Test for Radon?

- The second leading cause of **LUNG CANCER**.
- The **#1 cause of LUNG CANCER** among non-smokers.
- **21,000 lung cancer deaths** each year in the United States.
- **500 lung cancer deaths** each year in N.J.
